On 1/05/15 at 11:50 pm I met with the officers listed in the this report on _____, who were in contact with _____ as the subject of a traffic stop. Officer Langworthy and PFC Snider stopped _____ in that neighborhood for operating a car at night without headlights on; and also to investigate the possibility of a disturbance that they partially witnessed. The disturbance had occurred just prior to the traffic stop.

Upon arrival the officers informed me what they observed. I also briefly interviewed _____. The following is the basic statement that she provided.

_____ entered her car _____ while standing in the driveway of an address on _____. The officers advised they heard glass break, and saw the _____ drive off without headlights on, so they followed the _____ a short distance before stopping it on the next street. When they spoke with _____ she advised that she was just involved in a dispute with a Mr. George Zimmerman. The officers further learned from _____ that Mr. Zimmerman allegedly threw a bottle (glass) at her (or in her direction) while she was getting in her car. They also learned that Mr. Zimmerman allegedly broke her cell phone (described as having thrown it on the ground). _____ described Mr. Zimmerman as a "psychopath", and that she should have known better than to get involved with him.

_____ was upset and emotional, and she indicated that she didn't really want to "get involved". _____ indicated to me that for the last two to three months she has _____ with Mr. Zimmerman; and that they have had an intimate relationship. She indicated that this began at a time when she was emotionally vulnerable. _____ She further indicated that tonight's dispute involved a painting that Mr. Zimmerman wanted back, and that he attempted to take their relationship further than she wanted. _____ told Mr. Zimmerman that she did not intend to continue a relationship with him he allegedly got upset and caused this disturbance. Mr. Zimmerman allegedly made several threatening comments to _____ and threw her phone breaking it; additionally he allegedly threw a wine bottle at her (or in her direction) that broke in the driveway.

When I attempted to clarify portions of her statement, _____ made it clear that she did not want to participate in this investigation, and she refused to provide further details of the incident. _____ made a point to say that they "weren't dating" despite stating that she was _____ with Mr. Zimmerman and that she was previously intimate with him. She then started using the terminology that they were _____ and she reiterated that she didn't want to "get involved". It was clear to me that _____ intended to try to avoid any type of association with Mr. Zimmerman that would possibly become public at a later time; even if that meant not being an advocate for herself as a potential domestic violence victim.

I then traveled to Mr. Zimmerman's residence of _____ to attempt to make contact with him. After repeated knocks on the door, and attempts to call his known telephone number _____, no contact could be made with him. The broken wine bottle was found in the driveway of the residence; adjacent to the garage door. There were no other signs of a disturbance at the residence, and no one else appeared to be home. A business card requesting contact was left on the front door.

Subsequently, at this time the exact nature of the disturbance that occurred between _____ and Zimmerman is not fully known. _____ advised that she may be back in the near future to possibly retrieve her personal property from the residence; she advised that she would request law enforcement to escort her to the property at that time. Additional attempts to contact Mr. Zimmerman will be made. _____ was given a domestic violence pamphlet prior to her departure.

On January 5, 2015 I was conducting a routine patrol in area of _____ when I heard what sounded like glass breaking. I noticed a _____ bearing a Florida tag or _____ leaving the house from where I believed the noise came from. The vehicle seemed to be leaving in a quick manner. I followed the vehicle for a short distance to the next street over.

I conducted a traffic stop on the above mention vehicle because of the glass breaking and the vehicle did not appear to have any lights on. When I approached the vehicle I noticed clothes and blankets in the back of the vehicle. I then came in contact with the driver _____, identified by her Florida driver's license. _____ seemed very emotional and upset. When asked about the clothes in back of her vehicle, _____ stated _____ stated that she just left house I heard the glass break at. I asked _____ what happened at the house she advised that she had been in a verbal altercation over a painting, with George Zimmerman and that Zimmerman threw a bottle of wine in her direction when she attempted to leave. _____ also advised that Zimmerman threw her cell phone on the ground breaking it. _____ described Zimmerman as a "psychopath." I asked _____ if she and Zimmerman were dating she stated she had _____ with Zimmerman for two to three months and they had been intimate one time in the past.

_____ advised a few times that she should have known better than to get involved with Zimmerman. _____ stated several times that she did not wish to be involved in any criminal charges against Zimmerman. At this time I notified my supervisor, Sergeant Towler. Sergeant Towler took over the investigation when he arrived on scene.

On 1/09/15 at 19:12 hours Officer Clark and I traveled to _____ / to attempt to make contact with Mr. Zimmerman in reference to this investigation.

Upon our arrival we attempted to summon someone at the front door, and began to knock and announce our presence. During this time we could hear a television inside the residence, along with other noises that led us to believe that someone was home. After repeated knocking no one came to the door, but these noises silenced; we could also see lights on inside the home from the side windows. Also, there was a very large dog inside that would bark at the door knocking. After some time the dog stopped barking to the knocking; as if someone was silencing the dog inside.

Since no one came to the door, I went to a next door neighbor's house to try to find out if they were familiar with the resident at _____ so, other people in the neighborhood came up to the residence to see what was going on. An unknown adult female approached me and said that she had a telephone number for Mr. Zimmerman, and she asked if I needed it. I indicated "yes, please" and she offered a phone number o _____

I tried calling that number from my department cell phone and I left a message for Mr. Zimmerman to either come to the door, or call me back. After a short amount of time I began receiving calls from Mr. Don West (from telephone number _____ 37). Mr. West indicated that he was Mr. Zimmerman's attorney, and he began to inquire what the nature of the police investigation was at Mr. Zimmermans address. I informed Mr. West multiple times that I would not elaborate details of this investigation over the phone, and that I needed to meet with Mr. Zimmerman personally. From the nature of the these telephone calls, and from what Mr. West was telling me, it became obvious that Mr. Zimmerman was inside his home, aware of our presence, but reluctant to come outside.

I continued to knock and announce our presence, as well as make phone calls to Mr. Zimmerman, to ask him to come to the door and speak with officers. This occurred from approximately 19:45 hours to about 21:30 hours. During this time officers would knock on the front door for a short period, and then back away to the sidewalk/roadway in order to give Mr. Zimmerman multiple opportunities to comply.

I was finally able to get a hold of Mr. Zimmerman via cell phone, and begin to explain our presence. He indicated he would come outside if he could keep his attorney online (via his cell phone) with us while we spoke to him. I agreed, and Mr. Zimmerman eventually came outside.

I advised Mr. Zimmerman of a Miranda warning from a pre-printed card, and then began a conversation with him. Mr. Zimmerman voluntarily participated in this conversation while we were standing on his front porch.

Mr. Zimmerman indicated that he was romantically involved with the Victim, and that for some time she with him as a couple. When questioned about the incident that occurred at his residence his responses indicated that he was familiar with the incident.

Mr. Zimmerman denied having thrown a wine bottle at the Victim, nor breaking her cell phone. He stated that the Victim threw the wine bottle up against the garage door herself. He also stated that the Victim's cell phone had been broken by her child long before this incident. Mr. Zimmerman could not offer any explanation as to why the Victim would make up such allegations to the police. Additionally, Mr. Zimmerman indicated that he was unaware of my attempts to contact him previously; despite that fact that I left business cards on his door requesting contact.

Based upon the investigation I came to the following conclusions:

Despite the Victims lack of cooperation, and lack of motivation to provide police with a detailed account of what happened, I do believe that she was the victim of a aggravated assault (domestic violence related). Had the wine bottle actually struck her person, she could have been injured severely.

The manner in which she was confronted by police, and her basic statement about what occurred, does not suggest that she would have any time, or motive, to fabricate a story to the detriment of Mr. Zimmerman.

The Victim attempted to curtail her statement, and interaction with police, only once she realized that her disclosure of these events may lead to further investigation, and (based upon Mr. Zimmerman's status of being a nationally known public figure) possible release of embarrassing information to the public.

Additionally, Mr. Zimmerman's account of events holds little weight. Mr. Zimmerman has had a number of days to contemplate a response to these allegations, and also an opportunity to speak to the Victim after her contact with police. This, combined with attempts to avoid interaction with police altogether, lends to the presumption that his testimony lacks credibility; and that he is looking to minimize his potential exposure to law enforcement.

Furthermore, without some amount of intervention by police there is a possibility of further acts of violence to occur between the Victim and Mr. Zimmerman.

Subsequently, Mr. Zimmerman was arrested and booked into the Seminole County Jail.

On 1-5-15 I was riding with Officer Langworthy as his training officer. Officer Lanaworthy and I were on routine patrol in the area of [redacted]. As we were approachin[redacted] ve I heard glass break saw a female get into a vehicle. The vehicle was a [redacted] bearing Florida tag [redacted]. The vehicle backed out of the driveway of a house on [redacted] as if the driver was in a hurry. The vehicle began to drive on [redacted] a. The vehicle did not have any tail lights on and I do not believe the headlights were on. Based on the glass breaking (possibly an argument occurred or vehicle was broken into and stolen) and the fact the vehicle was being operated on a public roadway without tail lights and possibly headlights being out, Officer Langworthy and I conducted a traffic stop or

Officer Langworthy and I approached the vehicle, I immediately noticed clothes still on hangers and other household items as if the person was moving. Officer Langworthy and I made contact with the driver, identified by her Florida license as [redacted]. [redacted] was notified why she was being stopped (tail lights/possibly her headlights as well being out) and asked if she broke glass at the house she just left. [redacted] stated "he did" I asked who he was and she stated "that psycho, George Zimmerman". It should be noted that [redacted] was extremely emotional, crying, mad and upset. [redacted] stated several times she should have known better to get "involved" with George. [redacted] also stated she did not want to be "a part" of this investigation. I explained to [redacted] we needed to know what happened and make sure no crimes occurred due to us hearing glass breaking and her admitting to a disturbance. I asked what happened and she stated the following: I met Mr. Zimmerman approximately eight to nine months ago while at work. [redacted] stated she needed a place to live [redacted] approximately two to three months ago. They got into a fight so tonight [redacted] stated during the argument her cellphone was thrown to the ground by Mr. Zimmerman. [redacted] also stated when she was getting in her car, Mr. Zimmerman threw a wine bottle in her direction but was not very specific with me where exactly it was thrown.

I then began asking [redacted] about her and Mr. Zimmerman's relationship and she seemed as if she did not want to provide that information to me at first. [redacted] then went on to tell me they were [redacted] but she did get drunk in the past and have sex with him before. [redacted] continued to get agitated, I explained to her my supervisor, Sgt. Towler, was on his way to speak with her. Sgt Towler arrived on scene a short time later and took over the investigation. This was the extent of my involvement.

On 01/09/2014, at approximately 1936 hours I responded to assist units at [redacted] in the City of Lake Mary, in reference to an attempt to make contact with the resident at the above mentioned address.

Upon arrival, I was informed by the officers on scene that all attempts to make contact with the resident, George Zimmerman, have gone unsuccessful. While standing in close proximity to the front door, attempting to make contact with Zimmerman, I could hear the sound of footsteps coming from inside the home.

Then, at approximately 2130 hours, Zimmerman came out of the house and informed officers at the front door that he would be video conferencing with his attorney while our interaction with him took place. Sgt. Towler read Zimmerman his miranda rights and began to inquire about the details of an incident that had occurred on 01/05/2015. When Zimmerman was questioned as to whether he knew a female by the name of [redacted] his answers seemed to be somewhat evasive, in that he said, "Yes, I have a niece [redacted] It was determined by admission of Zimmerman that he was familiar with the [redacted] that was being referred to, and in fact they were involved in a dating relationship; during which she [redacted]. When questioned about the incident that occurred on 01/05/2015, involving him throwing a wine bottle at her while she stood in the driveway, Zimmerman denied knowing how the broken bottle ended up in his driveway. Zimmerman also advised that on the evening of 01/05/2015, [redacted] arrived at his residence and was causing a disturbance by banging on his front door repeatedly. Zimmerman advised that at no point during the night did he allow [redacted] into the home. When questioned about how [redacted] cell phone was broken, Zimmerman advised that he does not know how it happened, but that it was caused by [redacted] child approximately one year prior.

Zimmerman was then placed under arrest and placed in the backseat of Ofc. Clark's patrol car.

On 1/09/15 at 19:12 hours Sgt. Towler and I went to _____ / to attempt to make contact with Mr. Zimmerman in reference to an investigation.

Upon our arrival we attempted to make contact with Mr. Zimmerman. There were several lights on inside the home. I also heard noises from a TV, as well as other noises which would indicate that someone was home. There were indications that a dog was inside due to the occasional barking. Sgt. Towler knocked on the door several times. He also rang the doorbell which sounded. After a short period of time, both the TV noises and the barking dog ceased. No one answered the door.

Since there was no response, Sgt. Towler went to a neighbor's house to speak with them. While he was speaking with them, I spoke with another neighbor to inquire if they knew if Mr. Zimmerman was home to see if they knew what type of vehicle he drove, and if he kept it in the garage. The neighbor stated that Mr. Zimmerman keeps a grey SUV type vehicle in the garage, but he was not aware if he was home or not.

Sgt. Towler was able to get a couple different phone numbers through his investigation. While he was on the phone, I made several more attempts to have Mr. Zimmerman come to the door. I identified myself as a police officer with Lake Mary Police Department, but there were still no answer. We continued to knock for short periods and then retreat to the roadway to allow Mr. Zimmerman ample time to comply.

Sgt. Towler was finally able to make contact with Mr. Zimmerman by phone. A short time after the initial contact, Mr. Zimmerman exited the house. Sgt. Towler immediately advised him of his Miranda Rights from a preprinted card and then conversed with him. Mr. Zimmerman conversed freely with Sgt. Towler in the entry area of his home.

Mr. Zimmerman indicated that he was romantically involved with the Victim. He also stated that she was living with him for a few months. When questioned about the incident, he stated he was aware of what happened.

Mr. Zimmerman denied throwing a wine bottle at the Victim, or breaking her cell phone. He stated that the Victim's cell phone had been broken by her five year old child a year before this incident. Mr. Zimmerman was not sure why the Victim would make such a claim. After further conversation, Sgt. Towler went to the patrol car. Mr. Zimmerman talked to me about some paintings he did since he had some free time. He also spoke of his dog that he had trained in German and was certified by a local pet facility.

Upon Sgt. Towlers return, at 2134 hours, he placed Mr. Zimmerman into custody. He was handcuffed using two sets of handcuffs. They were double locked and checked for tightness. He was transported and booked at the Seminole County Jail.

The Defendant did commit the act of Aggravated Assault (Domestic Violence) in violation of FSS 784.021 by throwing a wine bottle at the Victim; the Victim is a female domestic partner of the Defendant

On 1/05/15 at approximately 23:30 hours a disturbance was discovered in occurrence at the address of _____, in the City of Lake Mary. Officer Langworthy and PFC Snider were on patrol in the area at that time and observed a female getting into a car at that residence. Their attention was drawn to that location further by hearing the sound of glass break, and seeing the Victim drive away from the residence without headlights on (at night). The officers stopped the vehicle and made contact with the Victim to investigate. Upon making contact with the Victim they learned that the Victim was just involved in a disturbance at that residence with Defendant George Zimmerman.

The Victim indicated to the Officers that she and the Defendant were in an argument over various issues. The Victim indicated that she was _____ with the Defendant for the past two (to three) months, where they have had an intimate relationship. The Victim indicated that at the time that the officers came into the area the Defendant had just thrown a wine bottle at the Victim. The bottle did not strike her person. The incident scared the Victim so she then departed the area in her car. During the investigation the Victim was extremely upset and emotional. She also indicated that the Defendant caused her cell phone to be broken by throwing it on the ground.

Attempts were made to contact the Defendant in an effort to investigate this incident further. The broken wine bottle was located in the driveway of the residence by this officer, and photographs were taken. Several attempts were made to contact the Defendant by knocking on the door, and calling known telephone numbers for the Defendant. No contact could be made with the Defendant at that time.

Contact could not be made with the Defendant on the date of 1/06/15. During this investigation this officer consulted with the Office of the State Attorney regarding this case; confirming the domestic nature of their relationship.

Contact was finally established with the Defendant on the date of 1/09/15 at approximately 21:30 hours. At that time the Defendant was

The Defendant denied throwing the bottle at the Victim, and denied destroying the Victim's cell phone. The Defendant indicated that he was trying to prevent the Victim from entering the home at the time of this incident.

Based upon the investigation the Defendant was arrested for Aggravated Assault with a Weapon (Domestic Violence) and booked into the Seminole County Jail.
